Mar 20 - Trench 23 - Morning 14 men - all in east extension north of Trench 1. Began east of Trench 1. Started branch 7.50 m. north of V-5. Began using pulsed parrots. 2 of them to remove pump filter on V and this north branch. Stop work on K & A on account of danger of large stones falling in. Found there yesterday 2.30 m. below surface is underground running east west & apparently supports it.

Mar 21 - Trench 23 - Morning 16 men - Finished 5-4 which now goes to depth of 6 m. It contains nothing important. Connected branch starting 7.30 m. north of V-5 with Trench 23 at V-5 (see plan p. 4 photo III 243). Started branch 0-2 south of K-Λ - dump & many stones under surface. Many stones under surface.
