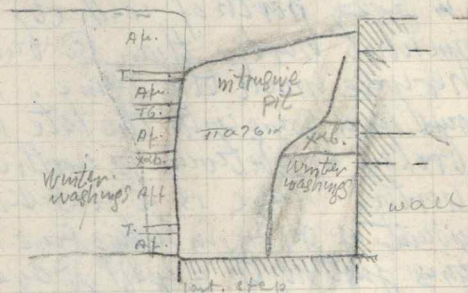

Finished removing Grid (A-100-15)
- 1 north 0-2, south 0-2,
strat 2 ② and began removing
strat. 2 ②. Strat. 2 in this
area over fine wall is harder than
2 in area north of wall. ② is
somewhat harder than ② but
otherwise much the same. The
ground level going with the late road
is broken up between 2 north and
4 north. There is a considerable
amount of debris including some large
stones just north of wall in area
where ground level has been broken
into. Strat 2 ② is very hard.
See Film 115-11. Beginning 1367 & 1371
strat 7. west of 4th step from top
and 1000-145 m. north of fine wall
consisting of clean sand. Strat 7 ②
0.00 - 1.00 m north of wall contains
more earth. it forms part of intrusive
pit extending further west here into
Pit 60. Hardly any shards but all kept.
Have thrown no shards out anywhere
this season. Removed fill of
intrusive pit sunk into Grid E-I
north 22-24. Strat 2 see
Film 115-12 (p. 1406). Began removing
1st strat in area between Pits 64 &
43. Grid 2-C north 0-4
Truck carried 3 loads of fresh dump.

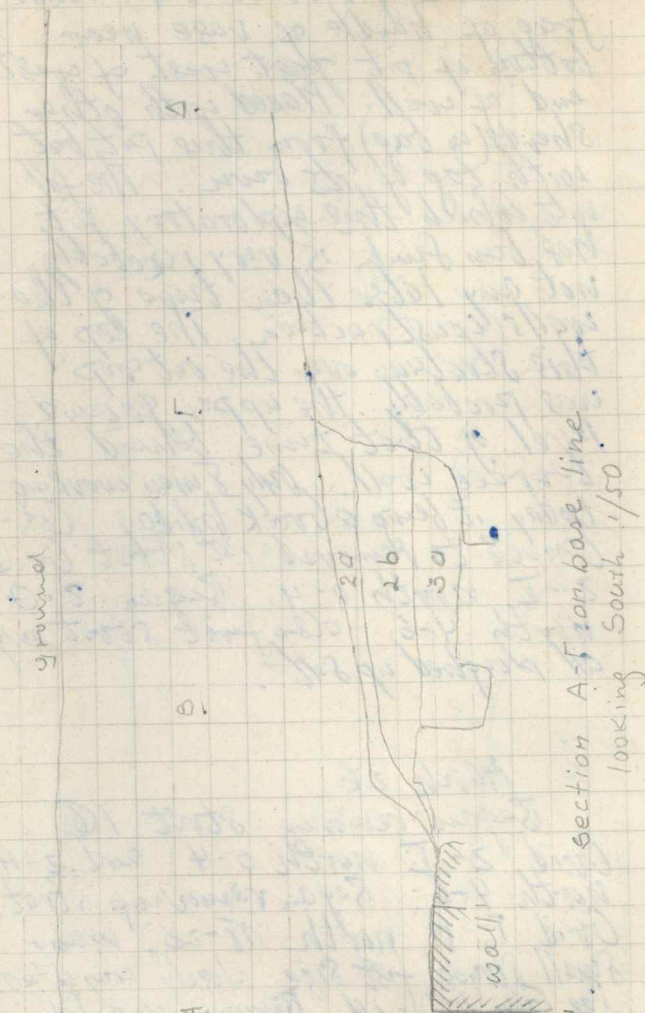
March 24

Mr. Hill arrived at Mesia airfield from Athens last night. Clearing out part of Pit 60 behind wall of earth which had come in since war. Digging Grid 2-II north 8-12, Strat 1 @ depth 1.15 in. Digging Grid 2-I north 2-4, Strat 1 @ 2 loads of earth in truck carried off up until 8:00 AM. Removing Grid 2-I north 0-4, Strat 1 @ up to 3:30 PM truck took 8 loads. Two men & driver working alone. Only fresh dump removed which is much easier to handle than old dumps. Dug exploratory pit at starting pt. level of top of terrace wall (Pit 60) about 50 cm wide in South-North direction at point about Grid B south 0-2. Down to what appears to be bedrock (conglomerate, sand & charcoal) behind wall or to South of it. Strat. dug into (Strat 3) quite hard - very few stones except near wall. Truck carries off eight loads.

March 25

Continued exploratory pit mentioned yesterday down to what appears to be edge of outcrop west of what seems to be furthest westward.

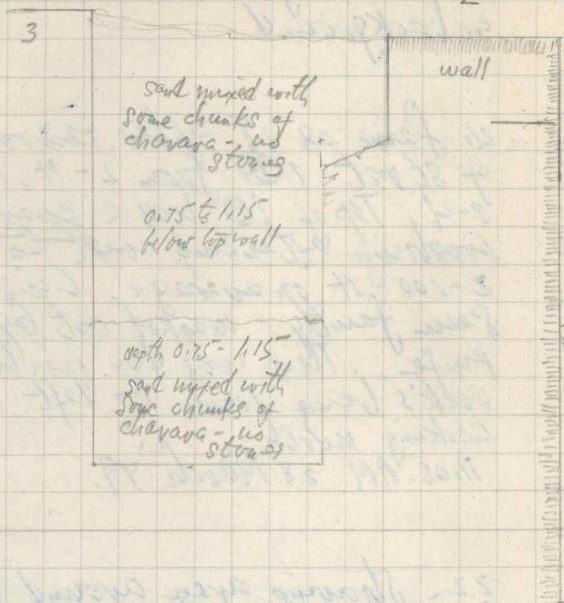
