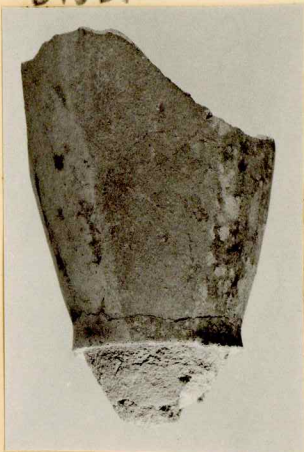

Blue green. On the bevelled edges are three sets of two connected ovals with solid blue centers and three fine blue rings around them the whole decorated area being reserved in white. In another case a more or less circular single unit has been substituted for the double oval
