Missing section of rim from nozzle through one side.

Clay gritty reddish-brown with black bits. Fabric heavy.

Rim flattened and flaring, but made to stand more or less erect. Body narrows down to small flattening for base. Base beneath roughly finished.

No dec. White accretion in spots.

Diam at nicholder 10,9 cm.
