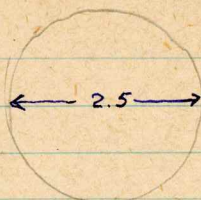

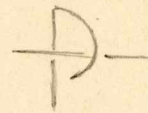

Clay Fragment of Vase?

Rounded on circle 0.26 in diameter. Clay c. 0.01 thick. Upon this a ridge extends out 1.5 cm about .5 cm thick. Above this but back from edge a square column 1.5 cm wide, standing 1.5 cm away from next square column. Below this ridge, dentilation. Dents 1 cm long. Below dentilation, egg and dart moulding without any dart. Egg and dart moulding extends back from outside dentilation about .3 cm. The outer edge of egg extends down 2.5 cm, the next ridge 2 cm. The width across to outside edge is about 2.2 cm. Inside ridge about 1.8 cm.

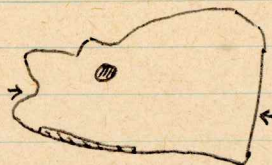

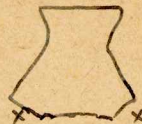
