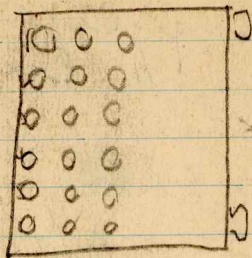

The Spanish line of battle-ship "San Pablo" which escaped from Trafalger afterwards came to Havana under the name of "Soberano". On a return voyage to Spain she put in here leaky and never left the port. She was used for a long time as guard ship and finally was abandoned and sunk sometime in the '50. Afterwards she was set fire to and the upper works burned off.
