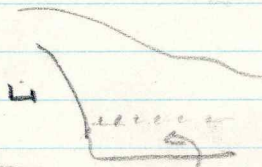


? Figure 5-1-11 - "archaic" - low brick wall above Grav #2.

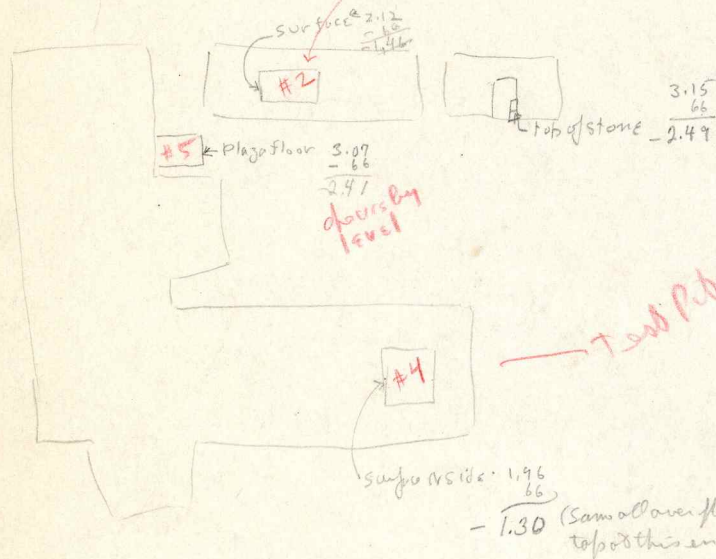


Levels Main For Cross Section
