Mar 4. To Camp, arriving about 6.45 (dark from Pavenin). Had an hour or so when I road head, took a desecho and got started back on old trail. Baltasar had to come back and find us.

Mar 5. (Sun) Unpacked a minimum, rested (pretty tired)

" 6 Unpacked. Men still at work on houses. Ot'

7 Getting settled. Took W.S.G. over Anopolis. Men men arrived (Yd. 19)

8 " " ; 3 men bushed some west group monuments, trail through Anopolis.

9 13 men bushing, others completing camp. Felling trees on K-5. Began excavating at 3.00 P. M.; Erected tarpaulin-tables etc.

10 Excavating K-5: felling and removing trees.

Benj., K-5-1st Bld. Platform - located indentation.

5x70 - K-5-2nd - joined outset, left upper (a nest to upper) outset to the wall & plaster (floor) lower farther in; cleaned upper part of old trench. Have 2 wheel barrows carrying his debris (He is ahead of them).

Anocelio, Ramiro + 2 barrows on K-5-3rd, left side - exhausted top of plinth to-day; fair headway on dump and debris outside it.

W.S.G. - yesterday + to-day transcribed plan + sections from J.A.P. hypothetical reconstruction. We outlined dumps, proposed trenches, etc. - a control sheet.

Bushed plaza, J-1 to middle of J-2.; Ball Court. (5 men) Took W.S.G., Customs Inspector, through South, Group, P-7, etc.

Mar 11 - Sat.

Pud Pancho outside rear of K-5-2nd fl.; Anacel continuing along rear to mud hill, but on lower level (of K-5-3rd); Benj. on K-5-1st fl. - getting details of upper terrace. Indications of 2 K-5-1st periods on pyramid. C. Ramiro moving dump + debris right of K-5-3. Sixto, front of K-5-2nd fl. Others bushing plaza. Rest of cargo arrived.

Mar 12 - Sun. Unbociering, arranging office etc Celeador (Pan Emilio) left.

Mar 13 - All men at camp, building house for Smiths; various camp jobs. W.S.G. + L.S. to K-5 in P.M. to draw K-5-1st details.

Mar 14 - 1 man at camp repairing, unbociering food etc; 2 on house. (1 of these to hill in P.M., 2 men felling trees + chopping.)

Benj.; Pancho; Anacelio continuing, helpers for last two.

Ramiro with 2 helpers continuing.

3 men at rt bottom - building wheelbarrow track, removing loose fallen stone.

Victor wrote letter - want Alberto (cook) fired - says he is moving trouble felling. Checked with Benjamin who said there had been no trouble this year, as yet.

Mar 15 14 men on K-5. Cutting up trees

K-5-1 - Benj working out at side Bldg. platform - found ~~head~~ hole. found corners of the indented unit; stop against it as front probably in line (very bad). Following this from center (@ 3.00 P.M.).

Manuel + 2 w.b. continue cleaning loose stone on slope, rd. side.

K-5-2 - Sixto continues, with 2 w.b. cleaning left side of front + enclosing.

3rd Pancho, no helper, on rear left terrace (P.M. started 2 men (moved from ^{high base of walls (T. 11?) on K-5-2nd floor, rear of inside of K-5-3.} Sixto) cleaning a track for rear section ^{the w.}

Anacelio + helper going down on same, near rear corner. He probably has fill wall in fill against K-5-3, @ 15 to 16, at road 2.00 from corner (no measurement) - will get it deeper.

Ramiro, Augustin + 2 helpers - cleaning fill, + rent half left side of K-5-3. looking for J.O.M.'s step down in K-5-2nd floor, just inside left wall of 3rd; find lot of small loose fill, nothing we can follow.

W.S.G. made 1:50 central plan of K-5-2nd from TP ~~diagram~~.

Talked Victor out wanting Alberto fired; seems entirely satisfied. He agreed to all my hints - said he merely ought to advise me. I told him Berthé would go on hill if Guadalupe comes. V. says the ~~code~~ ^{message} is naturally serious, and is not discontented.

K-5-1st - Benj. in front of upper Bldg. plat. terrace - mo > 6 of day on a hard drunk.



2 boys in loose stone (wheel barrels) - doubled one in PM to Pancho.

Manuel searching stair slope.

Pancho found probable law terrace ad rear (earlier than K-5-1st?)

K-5-1st fill wall.

K-5-2nd - Sixto working down on left hand terraces.



Mar 17 - cont'd. Felled large tree and friends - started cutting up.

Pan Ulises de la Cruz, Gaspar etc. arrived in evening. Our rules left same day, should arrive tomorrow.

Vida failed to give flour out (MCS checked up) - said because manteca very low.

MCS offered 15.00 here for Toby (1.00); 10.00 each for Hawley, Murray and Mico de noche (? - or some other animal).

Checked Bodega - low on manteca.

Mar 18. 18 Men. Pedro, Rufino - finishing south shelter, came for our coals (both have injuries. 16 on K-5.

7 men hauling & cutting up big tree, till about 9.00 a.m.; left 2 cutting up last sizable tree for rest of day.

Mar 19 (Sunday) - LS dev. 1 day films, fixed dark room. Repaired LS house.

Mar 20 (Monday). 16 on K-5; 1 for guano, 1 moving to pericos at camp, 1 (Miguel) sick. Hauled out last big tree with all gear; repaired pole cover on truck; 1 boy chopping out small trees at back, started felling those toward ball court, for friend camera shots of whole pyramid.

K-5-1st - Ben. at top: followed base of Bldg. wall to side out side - no plinth. Identified second indented Bldg. platform inside the first.

Manuel rolling loose stone to base of stony, 2 boys carting it to chow dump on trail.

K-5-2nd - Six to down to terrace behind which marks 2 boys hauling his stuff. We are leaving the corners, and not cleaning up the stony yet.

- Amocelio moved to left rear corner, failed to find out side on the terrace based just above K-5-3rd plinth (I checked it before we went around a substituted one.

- Pancho waving left from his trench on next lowest - passed

Mar 20 - cont'd -

Mar 21 18 on hill in P.M., 17 in A.M. Miguel sick; Pedro Maya for long with Rutino's home - could manage it + came back empty handed

K-5-1st - Benj. - went across front of Bldg. platform almost to 3rd end (big tree stump let'd ad edge. Started looking for stairway block.

- Pando recounted horrible rear terrace (left) - probably for pit. Found few orange shed outside the wall. - 2 haulers.

- Ramiro starting in ad near center.

- 2 hauling from center; Manuel handpicking stone in string.

K-5-2nd Sixto continuing on front terrace ("F" for Godfrey) - just above stela terrace - good shape. 2 hauling.

K-5-3^d - Sisimoy (Agustín) a horizontal slice on - 3rd level front-left of temple. cleaned out his walls partly - don't understand them. Some sheds, traces of wattle clay. 1 hauling.

K-5-1st - 3 picics remaining fill against ^{K-5-2nd} terrace, to center. (see memo "C")

3 " moving main left side dump.

1 Finished Pancho pit, left Orian (early).

1 picic 2 baranas - started center debris end up left side (Pancho)

Victor spoke about it last night - he says he recognizes the handwriting; felt he must do something as government representative. Benj is my best man. got him to agree to talking to her - howling and no positive proof - went to warn all the boys. We had a session with her this a.m. and this was done; Victor had prepared a notice which I suppose he has posted. I pointed out to her (see suggestion) that with so many bachelors she must avoid them; that it is an unsuitable place for a young woman. She agreed and says she will go to Tenosiquis Monday.


Eugenio Novello, of Agua Azul came in from Fla.; present with Victor + me with small bottle of lickee each. Bought mine.

Hope it doesn't start Victor chinsing.

The Pancho shed pit seems to show lot stuff, top to bottom (about 1 meter, part of this against a wall which may be K-5-1st). Gray earth and broken stone, stands.

Mar 24 18 Men on K-5 - 1 sick.

K-5-1st - 1 pick, 1 banaw attempting left silhouette ad center. - not too successful. Much more shake than I thought. Bare possibility of mosaic frames on upper terrace.
Going to clean whole face of loose debris (with pick). (has already been handpicked. (Panche).

K-5-2nd 1 pick (Benjamin - working out upper steps of K-5 - not st way. In fair shape, falling at side. nearly ready to drop with them ad edge.
- Found two more fragments of lintel 7, just below & in front of supposed block. One is the left hand unit, which fits. Paid 2.00 premi for each of the 3 now found
1 pick (Sexto) + one banaw (2 in a.m) on terrace "F" (was from stela terrace level). Ad about 1.00 above floor, appears to have been broken off. . Check terraces, lanes.
3 picks, 1 banaw cleaning rear of terrace "E" to center. Completed & photo'd (Wsg). Started to remove to get ad rear of K-5-3rd.

Pelrus - 4 banaws on lower stone ad yard
2 picks one banaw moving left dump.
1 Boy - fixing cosite, 1 with trunk, one cleaning camp (water to be fixed)

Rafino & albed tree, went wrong way. No call until he saw this - just missed Pedro Escalante, who stumbled as he ran.

1st 2 hours - all hands cleaning camp, digging house dirt around smith house etc.

Vida a bit tipsy in a.m. ad noon send no letter declining to give out mess food because they were complaining. I wrote him a reply and all seems serene. He will go on with books and organizing men out in a.m. He started lunch but came to dinner. We all wish he would dine alone as in other years.

Pena Rosa same & said boys would rather she left. Had a junta with her, + Inca Antonia, the other cook, & M.C.S. They get along well. Say the boys are always complaining. I think she will stay; I promised to appear to them (boys) but we decided to put it off for the moment. Discontent is in the air, but I think not serious. Antonia promised not to answer back if they grieved her, ad will probably blow over. Peggy giving out food will mean that they get what is proper.

Mar. 27

19 on K-5 - 1 removed to J-1 at 9.30; 1 ad camp making pick handles, putting new handles in shovels.

K-5-19 - Benjamin started for night music - stucco fragments & ad; a terrace wall apparently early - re-entered lower down.

2 - with 1 w.b.

Pancho following lower terrace to front, from center of right side; found 1st outcrop. Seemingly corner doubtful. - 1 w.b.

2 K-5-2nd - Manuel + 1 w.b. followed terrace F to front shadow of mask.

2 - Suso Jimenez + 1 w.b. cutting around large stump (from left of it - Sixto moved out till this is out.

2 Anacelis + Valentin followed possible rear building wall to right (nearly to right edge of mound.

5 men on J.A.M. dump (now roached)

5 Anster following upper steps to connect with 1937 side stony wall. 1 man bushing J-4 ad base.

J-1 Sixto trenched into base wall at left end.

L.S. + w.s.g. checked points of sod; found a .10 em (mid .30. Located in view of rather crude + hoarse character not worth while to check the found which appeared O.K. (3 arcs).

- Started main base line lay-out.

M.C.S. visited ruins in P.M.;

Very hot - the men show it; no shade.

L.S. worked on detailed program till 8.30 a.m.

Note on w.s.g.: Bill mend up just behind the men, leaving no in camp for the first time. He gave orders to the men for the first time the latter part of last (the 3d) week. He understands Spanish well, but has been very loath to use it; or to be left alone where he would need it. I hope I will be able to leave him alone on K-5 by next week.

He takes beautiful notes; some of his lettering is semi-lyric because meant to be beautiful. On this

He is quick as a flash.

Shows a decided tendency to let George do it.

He constantly asks "Is there anything I can do for you" from positions + in a manner which indicates an expected answer of "no". This is quite annoying. However, if you take him up on it, he will do it.

He is prone to a nervous laugh; has what I call

a superiority complex which he expresses by choice of remarks + tone of voice; instantly on the defence of anything affecting his judgment and, I think, looking for chances to show the other fellow's is or has been poor.

A most annoying habit (dislendingly juvenile?) is constant interruption. As soon as I am started doing one thing - as e.g. moving a man after discussion with him about it, the man waiting, he will call me about some totally unrelated matter. This is not occasional but constant - attention getting.

He has evidently been waited on a good deal; a typical example this morning: He started to climb the pyramid, to meet me on the other side. He carried a note book and the Buche tripod in its case with strap. He turned back and said "Bring this up when you come will you?" I replied "no, I have my own stuff to bring" (a filled his case + something else, I forged which. He said "all right", nod in a sore but in a slightly martyred voice. I have been handing the ball right back like this since we started.

He says exactly what he thinks about the food, what he wants, how it should be cooked, etc. This is OK but the manner + place is poor, and would make most people sore.

Minor bad habits - leaves things all over the main house when attracted to something else

Doesn't return borrowed things frequently - the bond here is apparent lack of real regard as having forgotten. In general, a simple statement "I forgot it", whether a job or something else seems to disappear of it in his mind, and should in yours.

I set all this down after three weeks as an impression to compare with later. Most of the negative points noted are probably due to youth + lack of experience in a real world and the job here should modify them somewhat. He will be thoroughly worth while having, and perfectly tolerable even if they don't, provided he gets some confidence soon in dealing with the men. He would realize his full potentialities until he gets over a tendency to laziness, and learns the difference between superficial good manners and real courtesy.

- Benj. ^{+ 1 wb} ran into mass of mosaic material in semi-weather; modeled fragments - about symmetrical to left, but far out from the corner found today. Maybe the other mosaic material slipped down - otherwise the eroded basal mosaic is a sorry wreck. Had his hand picking it most of day. Seems above of low level.

- In pulling down soft dirt above ths (thrown from right of center yesterday by Anstee - ad, above + below surface level of L-7 block, Benj. found another (edge) fragment of said level (good condition, but little remains of glyphs).

- Pvd Manuel on the dirt pile most of day - I slipped up in having a new boy finish the piece of above, + without warning. It was well to right of center.

- Anacleto found probable terrace "A" as right rear + near of right side - doubtful attempt to connect them, to be finished by us.

K-5-2nd - Cleaned up terraces for photographs (made 4 general) from 4 areas.

Since Victor was with him and nothing was said to Peggy, this doesn't make much sense. A very strange fellow. I made him begu I came asking if he wanted a man + he said no; I find four two

weeks after they got here. He attached (or permitted the boy to attach himself) to the one boy I had trained to be generally useful, to work overtime, to develop & run the road, and, to make sure he would stay, paid .50 a day extra. (Airsteo). I have said nothing, merely no to the proposal he go off Saturday. And it has been amusing. The boy ceased working overtime practically, once they were here and gave him the use of a gun. I could have assigned them anyone else for overtime without trouble, but never an I-ger or no.

His Peggy alternates between feeling sorry for the poor little fellow, and occasional annoyance. He had to be ordered to wear something above the waist in going to the bath; then after a week's hopeful wait, to wear socks. He had a habit of dangling his slippers (they are not bed room slippers however) entirely off, in the dining room. Even after this his wife started leaving hers on the floor when she pushed feet in the hammock, and once walked down the porch without them; but she seemed to catch on shortly after. All in all a little respite will be pleasant. There has been no overt unpleasantness whatever. Judging by my conversation about the socks, if I would make up a length, red of water, as for a child, he might behave better, but I'm afraid his wife would resent it. He doesn't generally brush his hair, but we led it go. It comes out to a sort of fluffy pompadour which is not so bad.

We have played hedge game a bit: simply can't get him to converse: the wife makes many efforts at it, but invariably about zoology, or Maya glyphs (she is reading Malley) neither of which interest Peggy particularly.
