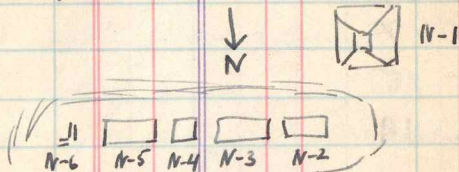

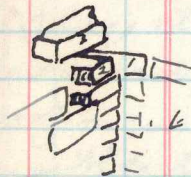

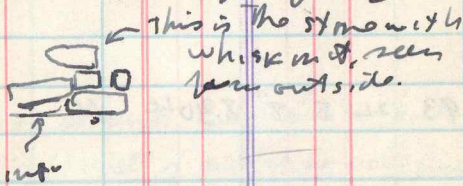

There is a pen white plug roughly 2-a, over the bed, which cuts off the floor 2-b. A piece of this went on to north (in picture) to mid edge of floor 3 (see earlier photos. A piece near the photo pencil was taken out by workmen in discovering the bed. I have chewed off some from the left side - i.e. although the hole for bed may extend under 2-b, it was probably hollowed out a little from same side I am working.
