✓ 33-200	R-3	NW	Latest temple floor, from its left end, badly dug up in foreground; at right, line of stones in position which formed a rear sill, completely ruined wall behind. The round column rests on this sill, but was placed there in 1932.
✓ 33-201	R-3	SW	A picture at right angle to the above, the ruler in same position in right foreground.

✓ 33-202	R-3	NE	Center trench; drude wall over 3rd terrace (see 33-199-a) removed.
✓ 33-204	R-3	NE	Looking at head of trench.
✓ 33-205	R-3	SE	Side of trench showing superposition of R-3 over R-3-2nd (Periods 1 and 2, respectively); ruler (and No. 4) rests on R-3-2nd floor; No. 2 (and whisk broom) on R-3 plastered floor, the former against the rear sill of R-3.

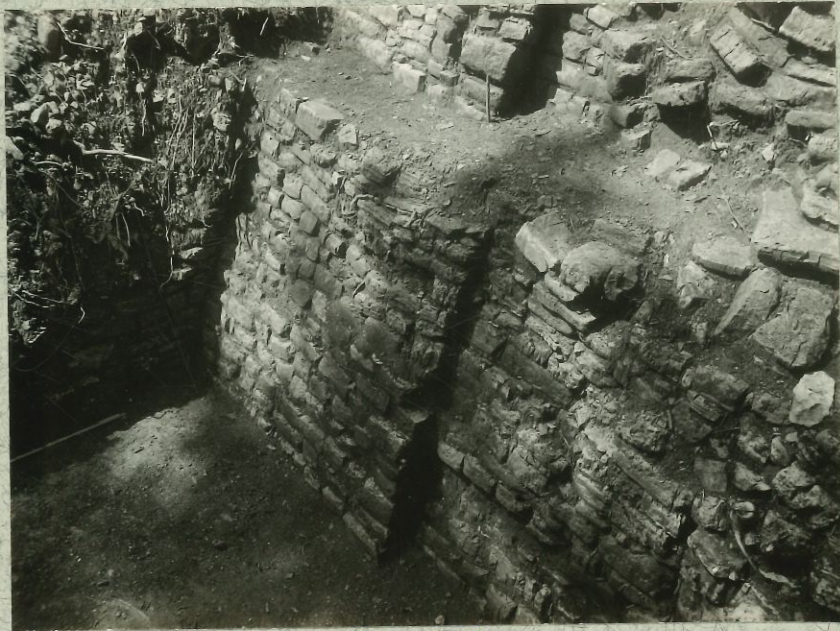

✓ 33-209	R-3	NW	End of above megalithic stairway, showing sloping risers, and end wall - no balustrade.
✓ 33-220	R-3	NW	Megalithic stairway, looking down the lowest step.
✓ 33-211	R-3	N	The lowest step of megalithic stairway, from tower looking down at angle of about 45 degrees; range pole is marked in feet, giving approximate size of stones.
✓ 33-212	R-3	NW	NWly side retaining wall of front stairway, Str. R-3, lower terrace at right.

✓ 33-219-a	R-3	NE	The Nly front corner, seen at an angle, from the front. Stela 44 beyond, and base of R-4 at right, close by.

✓ 33-235	R-5	SE	Rear wall seen from right (SWly) doorway rear doorway at right; the sill along rear wall is torn out by us except at extreme right and left.
✓ 33-236	R-5	NE	Cut section through debris on line from rear wall (right) through center of right (SWly) doorway (left); Note slabs, and depth of debris (about 1 meter.)
✓ 33-237	R-5	SW	Cut section through debris from rear wall (left) to front wall (right), on a line connecting NEly sides of rear and front left (NE) doorways. That is, only 50 cm or so from the NE NEly side wall. Note the fallen vault slabs on edge, at bottom. On the floor in front is a section of vault.

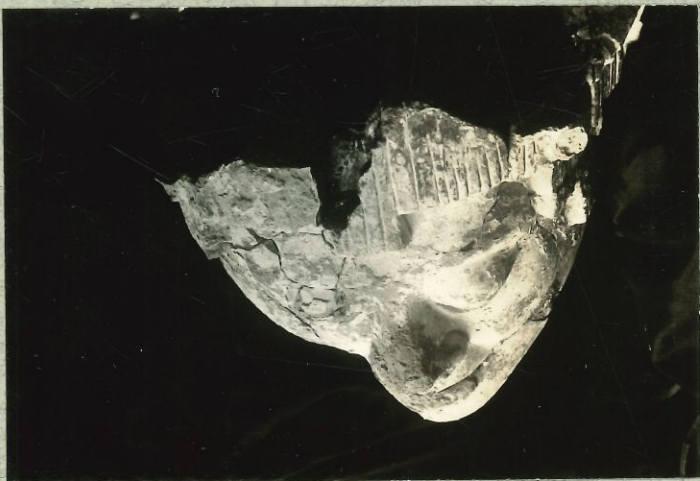

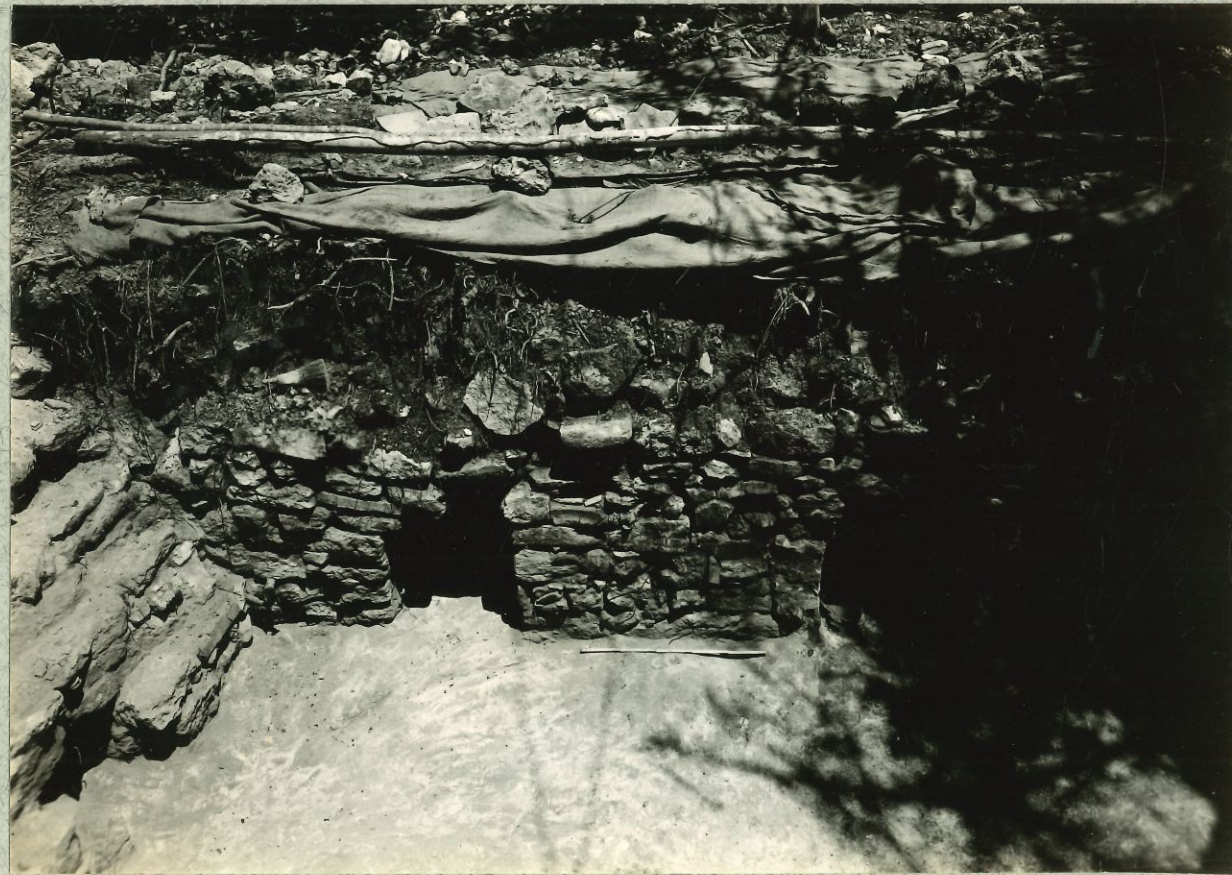
